The bulk of our school year will focus on kindergarten readiness by learning kindness and sharing, problem solving skills and social skills, letters, letter sounds, counting and number values, phonics, science, cutting skills, self-help skills, and so much more! I will send a monthly newsletter as well as an outline of what we will be doing that month and what you can be working on at home! I will send home a family activity homework calendar each month. This is completely optional but I will send home small treats with students who complete it and turn it in each month.
