



Get Ready for Take Off.....

Adventures in travel begin September 21 and 22 for our four-year-old classes.

We will be visiting all 7 continents this year and travel to Plymouth Rock in November and Bethlehem in December.

In our travel room, we have divided the room into two areas. One side is the airplane set up and the other side is the adventure side.

On the plane side we have assigned seats. The kids will receive passports before they travel. Each student will present their passport at the ticket counter before boarding the plane. The passport will be stamped and then they will be given their seat assignment.

After everyone is seated, we talk about where we are going, sing our *Continent Song*, watch a short national geographic video about the continent to which we are traveling. We have a snack (graham crackers) as we watch our inflight movie together.

When we land, we move to the adventure/experience side. The kids are handed a clipboard with a matching activity. They mark their sheet as they are led through the adventure. At the end of the journey, they will receive "homework" and a memento of the trip.
